Subject:	Town Appointment to the Town's Public Art Advisory Commission

Recommendation to Council:

Adopt a resolution approving the Mayoral appointment of Gunther Johnson to serve on the Public Art Advisory Commission, Youth Commissioner seat, pursuant to California Government Code Section 40605.

Strategic Plan Element:

The recommended action supports the goal of Organizational Effectiveness. Goal Statement: Achieve a high performing organization by nurturing an engaged workforce committed to a shared vision of public service.

Background:

On February 4, 2015, the Windsor Town Council established a Public Art Advisory Commission to serve in an advisory capacity to the Town Council for the purpose of planning and development of various forms of art and culture throughout the Windsor community.

The Public Art Advisory Commission is a standing citizen advisory committee composed of seven (7) adult Commissioners and two (2) youth Commissioners (grades 11th and 12th). Each Councilmember appoints an adult Commissioner for a four-year term coinciding with that of the Councilmember making the appointment, for a total five (5) seats. To be eligible for appointment to the Commission, one must be a resident of the Town of Windsor. The sixth seat is one member at-large appointed by the Town Council, who sits on the Town Council, and represents the Town Council on the Commission. The seventh seat is a one member at-large appointment, represented by a member on the Parks and Recreation Commission.

Discussion:

Since May 2024, the Town advertised for two (2) open Youth Commission seats on the Public Art Advisory Commission. Youth Commission seats typically serve a one-year term expiring in June.

The recruitment to fill the vacant seats were posted on the library's bulletin board, on the Town's bulletin board, the Chamber of Commerce's bulletin board and the bulletin board next to Safeway. Advertisements were also included on the Town's electronic sign at the corner of Exchange Bank, Nextdoor, the Town's Facebook, Town website, and schools to encourage Windsor residents to apply. The deadline for submittal of applications remained open until filled. One application was received from: Gunther Johnson.

With approval by Council majority, Mayor Reynoza will appoint Gunther Johnson to serve on the Town's Public Art Advisory Commission through June 2025.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact as a result of this item.

Environmental Review:

The recommended action is not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
