Subject:	Appointment to the Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District

Recommendation to Council:

Re-appoint Evan Kubota to serve on the Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District for a twoyear term through January 1, 2026.

Strategic Plan Element:

The recommended action supports the goal of Organizational Effectiveness. Goal Statement: Achieve a high performing organization by nurturing an engaged workforce committed to a shared vision of public service.

Background:

The Marin/Sonoma Mosquito and Vector Control District protects the health and welfare of the communities it serves from mosquitoes and vector-borne diseases by utilizing cost-effective, environmentally responsible integrated vector management practices. Each member represents his or her City (Town) or a County at large. The Trustees are appointed by their Council and may serve a two or four-year term. The first term of any member shall not exceed two years. Each subsequent reappointment, if any, may be for a term of either two or four-years at the discretion of the Council. On March 2, 2022, the Town council appointed Evan Kubota for an initial term of two years. Current Trustee Kubota has expressed interest in serving a subsequent appointment.
