Subject: Approval of Agreement with Sonoma County Community Development Commission for Management of the Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Ordinance

Recommendation to Council:

Approve agreement with Sonoma County Community Development Commission for Management of the Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Ordinance and authorize the Town Manager to execute said agreement on behalf of the Town.

Strategic Plan Element:

The recommended action supports the goal of Livability. Goal Statement: Preserve community character by maximizing the use of existing amenities and creating future opportunities that enhance quality of life for all.

Background:

Since 2019, the Town of Windsor has contracted with the Sonoma County Community Development Commission (CDC) to administer the Town's Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Ordinance (MHRSO). The CDC currently provides similar services to several other jurisdictions within Sonoma County. The current agreement with the CDC expires on June 30, 2026.

The CDC has proposed a three-year agreement to continue providing these services with an option to renew for an additional three years as necessary and agreed to by both parties in writing. This ensures uninterrupted administration of the Town's ordinance.

Discussion:

Under the proposed agreement (Attachment 1), the CDC will continue to provide day-to-day administrative services for the MHRSO, including responding to inquiries, managing arbitration petitions, securing qualified arbitrators, and facilitating hearings. The agreement also sets forth roles and responsibilities, including indemnity provisions and the Town's commitment to reimburse the CDC for services rendered.

Key provisions of the agreement include:

- **Term:** July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2029

- **Administrative Rate:** \$170 per hour, not to exceed 80 hours annually without separate authorization

- **Legal Services (if needed):** \$400 per hour for County Counsel services, not to exceed 90 hours annually without modification

- **Mutual Termination:** Either party may terminate the agreement with 30 days written notice

These updates are consistent with the Commission's countywide program administration model.

Fiscal Impact:

The Town of Windsor maintains a special revenue fund, the Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Fund, which can be utilized to initiate services per the Agreement. The fund currently has a balance of approximately \$12,000. The terms of the Agreement under consideration prevent the Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Fund from being exhausted without separate authorization.

Environmental Review:

The approval of this Agreement is not a project under CEQA, and, therefore, this action does not require environmental review.
