**ITEM TITLE:** Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a collective

bargaining agreement between the City of Yakima and the Yakima Police Management Group (Teamsters Local 760) for January 1, 2024

- December 31, 2027

## **SUMMARY EXPLANATION:**

City Management and Teamsters Local 760 representatives for Yakima Police Management Group negotiated in good faith, a contract setting forth the wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment for four years (2024-2027). To that end, both parties recommend the City Council review and approve the attached CBA proposal. The Police Management Group has voted and ratified this proposed agreement.

Highlights of the proposed CBA include:

- Established a pay separation structure to prevent wage compression issues between the supervisory groups
  - Lieutenants Step A shall be set and maintained at 9% in 2024, 10% in 2025, 11% in 2026 and 12% in 2027 above Step A for Sergeant
  - Captains Step A shall be set and maintained at 10% above Lieutenant Step A
- Juneteenth holiday added (consistent with other groups)
- Bereavement Leave added (consistent with other groups)
