SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

On November 29, 2023, Stephanie Beaman, on behalf of O. Jean Owens Revocable Living Trust, submitted a petition (Petition 23-07, RWV#002-23) to vacate an alley and a portion of N. Front St. between Bartlett PI. and N. 1st St. The intention of the proposed vacation is to fence a portion of City right-of-way that is not used for access to the surrounding properties. There is currently a sewer easement within the alley, which will remain as a result of this vacation. The proponents of the vacation will be required to work with the City to convey maintenance access to the sewer line.

On June 13, 2024, the Hearing Examiner for the City of Yakima conducted an open-record public hearing regarding the requested right-of-way vacation. On June 28, 2024, the Hearing Examiner issued a recommendation stating that the right-of-way be vacated subject to conditions, pending City Council approval.
