SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for City of Yakima Public Works to utilize Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) money that was made available to the City through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The funds will be used for construction of the aquatic center at Martin Luther King, Jr. Park. This is an \$11M project with \$10M collected from local donations, fundraisers, and other grants. The agreement shall terminate upon completion of the project.
