SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

The City of Yakima received the Washington State Department of Transportation Wide Hollow Creek Active Transportation Improvement grant for the Wide Hollow Creek Pedestrian Bridge Improvement Project.

The project consists of installing a new pedestrian bridge and constructing a pathway to connect on either side of the bridge at the Wide Hollow Creek located in the West Valley Community Park.

The state grant award is in the amount of \$900,000 and requires no match. The attached Resolution authorizes the City Manager to accept the subject grant. Staff recommends approval.
