ITEM TITLE: Resolution accepting the Yakima County Supporting Investments in Economic Development (SIED) funding for the Wiley City Sewer Feasibility Study

SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

The Community and Economic Development Division has been notified that grant funds of one hundred and twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) in SIED funding have been awarded to the City to be used conducting a feasibility study to expand wastewater services around Wiley City. The \$120,000 is 100% grant funding. Upon acceptance, Planning will work with the Wastewater Division to prepare an RFQ.

The City and County have agreed that this grant does not guarantee or obligate the City of Yakima for any associated wastewater projects that might be identified by the study.

City Council authorized submittal of a SIED application for this work on January 14, 2025 via Resolution 2025-019.
