SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

A donation from Forbes Mercy has been given in the amount of \$115,000 for the purchase and installation of outdoor exercise gym equipment at Chesterley Park and other programs and services. The donation is over \$50,000 and requires acceptance by City Council. The exercise area will consist of various non-moving equipment for park users to access for various types of physical fitness exercises. Park Maintenance staff will assist with the installation. The proposed plan and equipment drawings have been enclosed for City Council review. The equipment is stationary and durable and will not create additional operating cost.

In addition to the outdoor gym equipment, Mr. Mercy has indicated that he would like the additional funds to pay for items such as the domestic water for the irrigation at Tahoma Cemetery, Youth Sports activities, funds to assist with the cost for the flowers in downtown Yakima, the Fourth of July fireworks, etc. He has challenged the community to match his to assist in paying for these other programs and services that have been recently eliminated from the Parks & Recreation Division and the General Fund. Mr. Mercy is planning to speak in Public Comment.
